ROCKABILL CUP 2018 **HOWTH TO SKERRIES RACE**

SATURDAY 28th JULY 2018

NOR/Sailing Instructions

1. STARTING AREA:

The Starting Area will be in Howth Sound.

2. STARTING LINE:

The Starting Line shall be between a red vertical line on the East Pier Starters Hut and the South Rowan, a GREEN Mark- (Approx N53° 23.78' W06° 03.88'), which shall be left to port.

Boats shall keep clear of the starting line until their warning signal.

Warning!-There are submerged rocks NE of the South Rowan Mark

3. STARTING SIGNALS:

A Warning Signal will be made at the specified time and starts shall be in accordance with RRS 26.

4. COURSE:

- The course from the starting line will be in an easterly direction.
- The first mark shall be the Thulla Mark - Black Conical 'J' (Approx N53°23.80' W06° 03.40'), which shall be left to port.
- The second mark shall be the Rowan Rocks Mark -IALA, East Cardinal (Approx. N53° 23.88' W06° 03.22') which shall be left to port.
- Lambay Island can be passed on either hand.
- Rockabill shall be left to port before proceeding to the finish.

5. FINISHING LINE:

The Finishing Line shall be at the end of Skerries pier. The Finish line will be a line bearing 300 degrees from Skerries pier and bounded by a red buoy approximately 400 meters from the pier. A blue flag will be displayed on the pier. Note the red perch mark located ¼ miles NW of Red Island, Skerries, which shall be left to port.
