1. Details

The 2021 Skerries Sailing Club Regatta & Mermaid Leinster Championships will be held in Skerries Sailing Club on Saturday 24th & Sunday 25th July 2021. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* except where stated in this notice or the sailing instructions which will be available upon registration.

2. Time of Registration

All registrations will take place in **The Race Office, Skerries Sailing Club 9.00 AM to 10.30 AM Saturday 24**th **July.** Online Entry must be completed prior to this on -<u>www.skerriessailinclub.com</u>. All entries accepted at the sole discretion of the Race Committee

No warning signal will be given later than 14:30 on Sunday.

Individual starts may be given for classes of more than 5 boats. Classes of less than five boats, or any class, may be started with other classes, at the discretion of the Race Officer.

4. Entry Fee

Cruisers / Eboats: €50 per boat

Mermaid Leinster Championships: €50.00

Dinghies: €40 per boat (fireball, GP14, Wafarer, Albacore, RS double handed)

Single Hander: €25 per boat (lasers, Solo, RS single handers)

Junior Sailors: €15 per boat

For entry of other boats not listed please contact the sailing secretary to confirm. This will be at the discretion of the OOD.

5. Courses to be sailed

The courses sailed shall be identified to sailors in the Sailing Instructions.

5. Start Sequence

- 1. Cruisers 5 minute Sequence
- 2. Mermaids, Dinghies 3 minute Sequence

7. Scoring System

7.1 Dinghy Races

For Dinghies, five Races are scheduled of which two shall be completed to constitute a championship. The Low-Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A will apply; except that if less than four races are sailed all shall be counted. If 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her races excluding her worst score.

7.2 Cruiser Races

For cruisers, two races are scheduled, one race shall be completed to constitute a championship. The courses for the cruisers will be two bay races, the course being determined by the OOD.

8. Handicaps.

Cruisers shall supply their ECHO handicaps on entry or will be assigned a handicap by the Race Committee. Boats which are racing members of SSC shall use their designated original ECHO handicap.

9. Membership:

All entrants shall be given temporary membership of Skerries Sailing Club from midnight on Friday 23rd July until midnight on Sunday 25th July and free boat parking or mooring, where available, for the same duration.

10. Prizes.

10.1 – Cruiser Prizes

Cruiser Regatta prizes will be awarded at the main prize giving ceremony on Sunday afternoon.

10.2 – Dinghy Prizes

Dinghy prizes will be awarded according to class turnout, following racing on Sunday afternoon.
